Why Private Support is Important

Investing in Chi Phi ensures the continued success of America's oldest fraternity. Undergraduate dues and fees pay only 60% of the overall expenses to run a national fraternity of more than 60 chapters and nearly 2,000 students. Trust Donors Award \$65,200 Worth of Scholarships to 115 Campus Leaders

115 students received scholarships totaling \$65,200 thanks to the generous financial support provided by alumni and friends last year. Twelve of these scholarships were given in the form of UIFI (Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute) scholarships. UIFI is one of the premier leadership training programs for fraternity and sorority leaders, and Chi Phi is privileged to be able to send so many students.

103 students received academic scholarships during the last year. These merit-based scholarships award the outstanding academic achievements of undergraduate Chi Phi brothers.
